

SUBSTITUTE W-4P

The Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund is not the primary pension benefit received by many of its members and many of the monthly pension checks we issue are not large enough to require that Federal Income Tax be withheld. However, many retirees desire to have Federal Income Tax withheld from their monthly pension check.

Instructions:

Check Line (1) if you do not want any Federal Income Tax withheld from your pension checks.

Check Line (2) if you want Federal Income Tax withheld.

If you check Line (2), indicate on Line (3) the amount that you want deducted from your monthly pension to be remitted to Internal Revenue Service.

Even if you elect not to have Federal Income Tax withheld, you are liable for payment of Federal Income Tax on the taxable portion of your pension. You also may be subject to tax penalties under the estimated tax payment rules if your payments of estimated tax and withholding, if any, are not adequate.
